Symphony #14(IV) in D violin 2

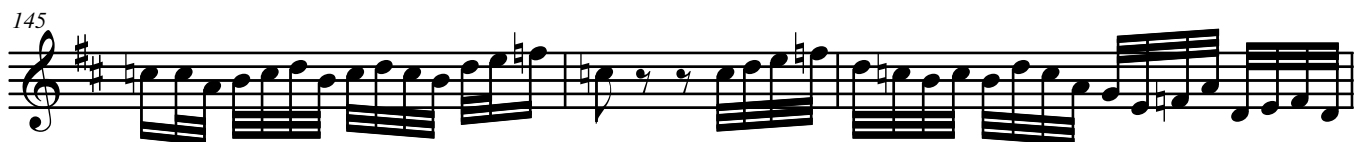
